SPECIFICITY: The antibody is specific to human vascular cell adhesion molecule (VCAM-1, 110 kDa) whose ligand is VLA4 (CD49d/CD29, alpha4/beta1 integrin subunits). The antigen is distributed across non leucocyte and leucocyte cells e.g. neural crest and fibroblasts, B cells, T cells, monocytes and large granular lymphocytes
KNOWN SPECIES CROSS REACTIVITY: Recognizes pig

APPLICATIONS: This antibody works both in ELISA assays and in immunohistological sections.
The antibody has applications in studies of cell-cell interactions.
The antibody inhibits cellular adhesion.
Western blotting.
Optimal working dilutions must be determined by the end user.

SPECIES REACTIVITY: Reacts with Human. Reactivity with other species has not been determined.

FORMAT: Purified by Protein-A affinity chromatography.

PRESENTATION: The conjugate is supplied as a 100 test/1 mL vial in phosphate buffered saline containing 10mM sodium azide and 1mg/ml bovine serum albumin. For flow cytometry we recommend using 10µL of conjugate per test.

STORAGE/HANDLING: Store at +4°C protected from light for up to 6 months from date of receipt. DO NOT FREEZE.
